



ROUND 2 – SPAIN - MOTORLAND ARAGON – 28/29 MAI IANNETTA & PERRIN, KING AND QUEEN OF SPAIN !!!

Under the hot sun of Spain and on the beautiful track of Motorland Aragon, the 2011 RACECAR Euro Series 2nd round proved once again how spectacular their races are. In ELITE Championship, Romain Iannetta is the big guy of this meeting: he wins the ELITE Sprint and leads the whole ELITE Endurance race ... before getting a penalty. Finally, Carole Perrin reaches her first victory.

In OPEN Championship, Romain Fournillier is the great winner. He brightly wins the OPEN Sprint and even the Endurance race after the Macanese driver, Jo Merszei, loses his victory due to the penalty of his ELITE co-driver Iannetta.

Sprint ELITE : Première for Iannetta

Starting from the first line near the poleman Lucas Lasserre, Romain Iannetta overpasses him in the third lap and flies to his first victory after only 3 participations in RACECAR. Behind him, the Spanish Ander Vilarino reaches a brilliant 2nd place heading the young Steven Palette and Romain Thiévin. Lasserre ends at the 5th place after a drive through due to a push with Eric Héлары who finally has to stop. Vilarino gets the best lap time and so will start the ELITE Endurance in pole position.

Endurance ELITE: Mademoiselle Perrin, first ever female winner in RACECAR Euro Series

Ander Vilarino gets no benefit from his pole position as he spins in the 1st turn. He can restart but will finally end at the 12th place. Just after, Thiévin and then Lasserre leads before Iannetta takes the head till the victory. It is only a short victory as the Stewards give him a 25" penalty for the push on Vilarino in turn 1. Carole Perrin finally wins and becomes the first ever female winner in RACECAR Euro Series. She's heading Lasserre, Thiévin, Lioen and Pernaut.

What a 2011 season beginning with more than 10 drivers who can apply for victory in each race ! Lasserre leads the ELITE Championship ahead of Thiévin, Perrin, Iannetta and Palette. Unlucky this weekend, Eric Héлары drops to the 6th place but only 34 points behind the leader. In Junior Trophy, Palette wins the Sprint and Perrin the Endurance. She so leads this classification for less than 25 year old drivers. In the Challenger Trophy reserved to non priority drivers, Antoine Lioen takes the lead.

Sprint OPEN : Fournillier is the boss

The poleman Vincent Gonneau leads almost half of the race but can't resist to Romain Fournillier who overpasses him and wins ahead of Tanguy Ide, who started from the 8th position, Emmanuel Brigand, Jo Merszei and Vincent Gonneau.

Endurance OPEN : Fournillier declared winner

Benefiting of the great run of his ELITE co-driver Iannetta, Merszei takes the lead after the driver switch. He has a good gap ahead of his followers and manages it till a victory that should have been historical for Macau in International FIA Series. Unfortunately, the penalty sanctioning Iannetta affects also his time and Merszei finally ends at the 5th place. The declared winner Fournillier takes the lead of the OPEN Championship ahead of Brigand, Ide, Merszei and Dermont who has reached his 3rd top ten and leads the Legend Trophy.
