



RACECAR EURO-SERIES 2011 ROUND 3 – THE NETHERLAND - 11/13 JUNE ZANDVOORT RACECAR FEAST

After the Aragon sun, the 2011 RACECAR Euro Series 3rd round happened under worse conditions. In Elite Championship, the Spanish Vilarino wins his 1st RACECAR Euro Series race and the Championship is more battled than ever. In Open, once again, Romain Fournillier reaches the victory.

Sprint Elite: Vilarino signs for the 1st Spanish victory ever!!!

After heavy rain in the morning that had hardly wet the track, RACECAR Euro Series drivers started with warm cheerings of a numerous Dutch attendance, present in spite of the bad weather. The poleman Lucas Lasserre makes the best start and still leads after the 1st turn ahead of the Basque Ander Vilarino who rised from the 5th place in front of Eric Helary. Begins then a true duel between the 2 drivers and in the 4th lap Vilarino overpasses Lasserre, takes the lead and keeps it till his final 1st victory in RACECAR Euro Series. It is also the 1st ever victory of a Spanish in these European Series. Lucas Lasserre keeps his 2nd place and Helary reaches the 3rd place of the podium ahead of Romain Iannetta who went up from the 8th place. Steven Palette finishes 5th and 1st Junior (less than 25). He is ahead of Sebastien Dhouailly, 6th which is a great finish for a rookie. Dhouailly also wins the Challenger Trophy.

Sprint Open: Fournillier from A to Z!!!

The rain stops only during the race and the track becomes very difficult with dry and wet parts alternatly. The poleman Romain Fournillier makes a good start and keeps the lead. Enzo Pastor coming directly from the Philippines right on the other side of the world, is the best surprise of the race. Starting from the 8th position in his 1st RACECAR Euro Series race ever, he quickly overpasses his competitors to target the leader Romain Fournillier. Unfortunately, trying to take the lead, he makes the fault and has to give up and let Romain Fournillier win the race. Behind, the raging Alain Grand reaches the 2nd place ahead of Tanguy Ide who finishes 3rd for only 1/10th of second overpassing Vincent Gonneau on the finish line. Gérald Cormon wins the Gentlemen Trophy and Grand the Legend Trophy.

Endurance Elite and Open: Results under investigation!

Raced on Saturday under the sun, the poleman Eric Héлары wins the Elite part of the Endurance race ahead of the young Willy Boucenna and Steven Palette. In Open Championship, Manu Brigand reaches the victory ahead of Tanguy Ide and Philippe Marie. But, because of a confused safety-car procedure, results of the Endurance Elite and Open race are still under further investigation before allocating the points.
