RACECAR EURO SERIES 2011 ROUND 4 – FRANCE – MAGNY-COURS – 2/3 JULY RACECAR DANCE FLOOR IN MAGNY COURS !

The 4th round of the RACECAR Euro Series 2011 will stand on the beautiful and fast Magny-Cours track, which celebrates its 50th anniversary. The 30,000 expected spectators will enjoy the hard fights of an ever boosted V8 squad. After half of the season, ELITE and OPEN classifications are still very challenged and everyone wants to reach victory lane. With the famous DJ Laurent Wolf as guest star, we can expect the Magny Cours track will look like a summer dancefloor.

In ELITE, the 1st half of the season knew 5 different winners in 6 races and almost 10 drivers can apply for the final champion title. Lucas Lasserre still leads ahead of Eric Helary and the rookie Romain Iannetta. But they will have to keep an eye on their back where their followers still target the NASCAR seat once again promised to the 2011 Champion: Steven Palette, leader of the Junior Trophy, Romain Thiévin, driver of the Fast Club, Ander Vilarino, the fast Spanish, followed by Olivier Pernaut and by the young-gun triplet Carole Perrin, Wilfried Boucenna and Romain Fournillier. Jerome Schneider leads the Challenger Trophy, for non-prioritary drivers. And don't miss the #8, where the famous DJ Laurent Wolf goes back behind the wheel after his last participations in 2009 and 2010.

In OPEN, the young Romain Fournillier leads ahead of the 2010 champion Emmanuel « Warrior » Brigand. They won the 6 first races of the season but if the young Tanguy Ide, very consistent, stays on the 3rd step of the podium, he will for sure target the leading duet. Philippe Marie, 6th, leads the Gentleman Trophy and Eric Dermont, 8th, leads the Legend Trophy for more than 50-year-old Open drivers. Seven drivers will here make their first start in RACECAR Euro Series which continue their international development: after brilliant Macanese Jo Merszei and the Philippines's Enzo Pastor, Michael Ho and Raymond Un will certainly try to place China's colors on the podium

Let's mix the warm temperature, the V8 sounds and the hot character of the RACECAR drivers ... Hot show, for sure !
