ELITE Championship:

The 2011 season has been very challenged with 6 different winners in 10 races. Of course, the leader of the Championship, Eric Hélyary, with 4 victories in 2011, is the favorite but nothing is done yet. They still are 6 to be able to reach the title: Romain Thiévin, Ander Vilarino, Romain Iannetta and also the 2 juniors Steven Palette (leader of the Junior Trophy) and Wilfried Boucenna. Antoine Lion (leader of the Challenger Trophy), Olivier Pernaut, Vincent Capillaire and Bruno Cosin (Challenger), who lie in ambush, will also take advantage of any mistake. They will all have to take care of Kevin Estre (2011 Porsche Cup winner), Pierre Ragues (ILMC) and Anthony Garbarino who come to discover the RACECAR Euro Series or either Christophe Anquetil and Sébastien Dhouailly who already demonstrated how fast they are this season. Panache and performance are the key words for this "Money time" Super Finale.

OPEN Championship:

With no doubt, Manu Brigand and Romain Fournillier are the favorites of the OPEN Championship. They gave us amazing battles all season long, sharing victories. But they have not won yet! The 2 young guns Tanguy Ide, with his 8 top 5, and Vincent Gonneau, winner of 2 of the last 4 races, can still beat them. And don't forget Jo Merszei who can be a spoilsport in the leading quartet. The final podiums of the Legend and Gentleman Trophies will also be contended and we can expect hard fights at every level of the race with highly motivated Jerome Laurin, Alain Grand and Philippe Marie.

It will really be a Super Finale and the mythic circuit of Le Mans will be the only judge to decide between the RACECAR Euro Series' drivers who don't benefit of any assistance from their racing machine just as the NASCAR ones. They just can lean on their talent. Not to be missed!
